CHARDONNAY 2018 RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

VINEYARD

Sourced from various sites throughout the Russian River Valley from notable sources: Draxton, Dutton Bros. and Bialla vineyards, which have garnered acclaim for producing world-class Chardonnay.

WINEMAKING

Pressed immediately and placed into stainless steel tanks with cold glycol set to a lower temperature to allow for a slow and easy fermentation. Once two thirds through, the wine goes to French oak barrels to finish primary and malolactic fermentations. Throughout the process the wines are stirred to kick up the lees (dead yeast cells) which helps add to the mouthfeel and complexity.

TASTING NOTES

The nose suggests fresh stone fruit and toasted spices. The palate shows the bright acidity and citrus structure that fills the mouth. Peaches, apricots and Bartlett pears with mandarin zest are blended with hints of vanilla and cinnamon toast.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS

Grilled halibut with a mango and lime zest salsa.
