Cherry Pie Rosé of Pinot Noir

This inaugural release of Cherry Pie Tri-County Rosé of Pinot Noir is like an exhilarating drive along California's coastline. Vineyards close to the Pacific Ocean have a long growing season which allows grapes to have a harmonious ripening of sugars, tannins and acid, as they slowly reach their full flavor and structure. While Pinot Noir can often be finicky, it thrives in the cooler temperatures created by the offshore breezes and the blankets of evening fog.

Tasting Notes

The elegant color of the 2021 Cherry Pie Rosé is the shade found inside the petal of a cherry blossom. The aromatics are a beautifully complex mélange of ripe peach, tangerine and pink grapefruit. Bright and refreshing on the palate, the balanced acidity mingles with layers of citrus, watermelon and Queen Anne cherries, evolving into a fresh and lingering, satisfying finish.
