COMPOSITION

43% Pinot Noir, 27% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Merlot, and a blend of Cabernet Franc, Malbec and complimentary varieties

TASTING NOTES

This wine is zingy with tart apple, fresh cantaloupe, lemon zest and candied fruit on the nose. Flavors of white peach, Meyer lemon and red raspberry dance across the palate, leading to a fresh finish with lingering minerality.

WINEMAKING NOTES

The year started out with ample rainfall which kept the soils moist and cool into spring. Summer was marked by warm, even daytime temperatures with few extreme heat spikes. The opportune weather conditions continued into late summer and fall. The harvest was of average volume, if not slightly below average and the fruit quality was exceptional. The select vineyard sources for this Rosé afford an abundance of character, vibrant acidity and finesse.
