The high quality of oak is evident on the nose, complex layers of vanilla, cocoa bean and coconut husk give depth to this wine. Red and dark fruits comingle, blackberries with cassis and raspberry notes fill out the mid palate. The tannins are bold yet balanced well, driving the finish. There is a slight mineral note to this wine, reminiscent of the well drained soil next to the creek where the vineyard lies.
