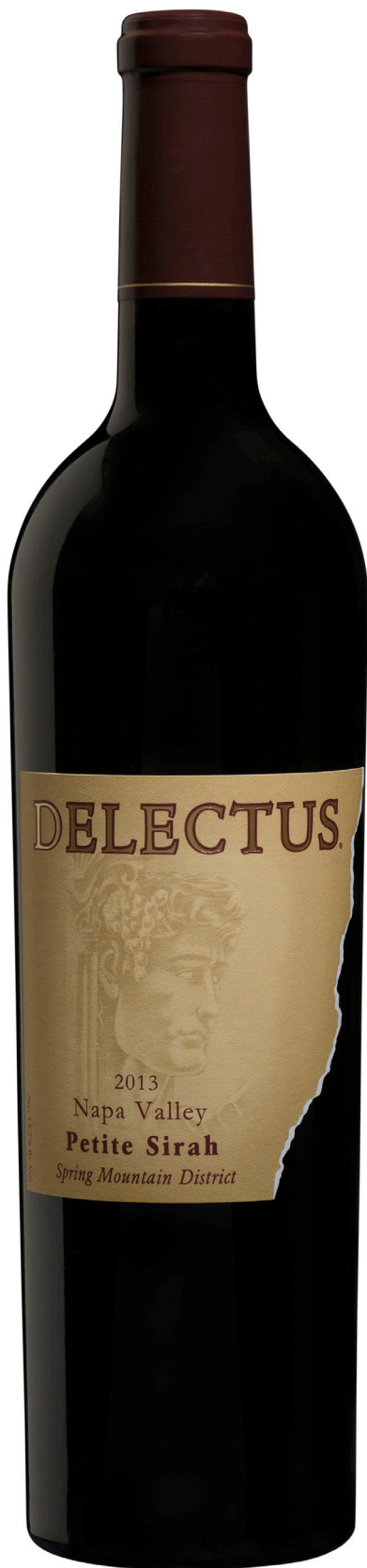

TASTING NOTES

Surprising from the moment it is poured, the inky-black 2013 Petite Sirah displays poise and muscle at the same time. Aromatic notes of black pepper, smoke, anise and black licorice vie for attention. The polished, round, ripe tannins are evidence of perfectly-ripe fruit. Exceptional balance with underlying power ensure continued enjoyment for 10-20 years.

York Creek was planted in 1911—the oldest Petite Sirah vineyard in Napa Valley—high up on Spring Mountain, west of St. Helena. There the terroir is conducive to making inky, concentrated wines of great distinction. That is the essence of Delectus.
