

2018 Firesteed Willamette Valley Pinot Gris

In 2018, after a dry dormant season with half of normal rainfall, favorable weather continued in the Willamette Valley, culminating in a truly classic Oregon vintage. Firesteed's Pinot Gris grapes were harvest over the course of a few weeks starting October 4th and ending on October 13th.

By blending several vineyard sources and avoiding heavy-handed winemaking techniques we hope to achieve a balanced wine focused on the abundant varietal fruit character of this classic grape.

In 2018 Firesteed Pinot Gris' Crenshaw melon and lemon citrus aromas meld with flavors of tropical fruit, lychee, citrus and Bosque pear. Mouthwatering and enticing, its bright acidity results in a well-structured wine with a clean lingering finish.
