2016 Firesteed Willamette Valley Riesling

In 2016, a warm spring and pleasant summer set the stage for an early harvest in Oregon's Willamette Valley and for a second year in a row, the later-ripening Riesling was picked nearly last on September 29th.

The 2016 Firesteed Riesling opens with aromas of peaches, ripe lychees, and the added floral elegance of ripe honeysuckle that comes across almost mead like on the nose. On the palate the wine is luscious, reconfirming the fruit flavors found in the aromas, and with a steel edge acidic minerality that balances the wine's viscosity.
