**VINTAGE NOTES**

The 2018 vintage proved nearly ideal with even ripening and a long, evenly paced harvest. Yields were slightly below average and grape quality was quite high.

**VINEYARD NOTES**

The fruit for this Sauvignon Blanc was sourced from select vineyards; one in Southeast Napa Valley, and the majority of the blend from a special vineyard in St. Helena, just across the road from the Culinary Institute of America. These vineyards are prized for producing bright, tropical fruit flavors—the hallmark of our Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc.

**TASTING NOTES**

The nose is vibrant with aromas of lemon zest, kiwi and melon. The palate is well-structured with vibrant acidity and flavors of tangerine, tart pineapple, and a hint of honeydew melon. The finish is refreshingly bright, displaying a taught balance between lush fruit and mineral notes.
