2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON OAKVILLE

VINTAGE NOTES

The year started out with ample rainfall which kept the soils moist and cool into spring. Summer was marked by warm, even daytime temperatures with few extreme heat spikes. The opportune weather conditions continued into late summer and fall. The harvest was of average volume, if not slightly below average and the fruit quality was exceptional, allowing us to craft wines with fresh brightness, texture, structure, and finesse.

VINEYARD NOTES

Our Oakville Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from a single vineyard spanning some 50 plus acres and planted with multiple rootstocks and clones of Cabernet Sauvignon. Situated at the northern end of the Oakville appellation, abutting Rutherford and just off the Silverado Trail.

TASTING NOTES

Inky ruby color in the glass, this Cabernet Sauvignon reveals aromas of silky red raspberry, dried fig, licorice, and baking spice. Full-bodied and juicy on the palate, waves of plum and boysenberry mingle with baking spices, savory dried herbs, mocha, and vanilla scented oak influences. The persistent finish is punctuated by bold, velvety tannins.
