VINTAGE NOTES

A dry winter was followed by warmer-than-average summer temperatures. Fruit set was even, with small, concentrated berries and clusters. Late summer heat and winds further concentrated the intensity of fruit flavors. Against a backdrop of pandemic and regional fires, harvest 2020 shaped up to be one of the most challenging in memory. We harvested far less fruit than we would have liked, but that which we did pick and craft into wine was of exceptional quality.

VINEYARD NOTES

The fruit for this Sauvignon Blanc was sourced from select vineyards; one in Southeast Napa Valley which lends the wine vibrant citrus notes, and the majority of the blend from a special vineyard in St. Helena, just across the road from the Culinary Institute of America which affords the wine luscious tropical fruit flavors—the hallmark of our Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc.

TASTING NOTES

The lively nose is bursting with aromas of tangerine, tropical fruit and kiwi. Medium-bodied and laced with minerality, the palate tingles with very acid, bright pineapple, stone fruit, melon, and zesty lemon flavors leading into a refreshing finish.
