On the night of July 20, 1969, we stared at the moon and listened to the radio chatter of the Apollo 11 astronauts. One voice boomed back to the listeners on Earth declaring, "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind."

This brand focuses on the emotions at play during the American Space Age, producing a grounded authenticity that speaks of the wine inside.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The grapes used for this rosé came from three select parcels in the Paso Robles appellation. The low-yielding Grenache vines are the basis for the tightly focused expression of fruit in this wine – peach, strawberry and watermelon. Having received very gentle treatment in the cellar, from gentle pressing through cold fermentation, the color is brilliant pale salmon, and the balance is decisively fresh, with delicate spiciness in the finish. Whether sipped poolside or paired with seafood, light pasta dishes or poultry, this is the perfect summer wine.
