THE WINE

A wine with personality to match its label: Deep garnet color. Aromas of ripe fresh picked blueberries with hints of leather, clove and sage. Full bodied with black bramble fruit and star anise flavors. The wine is juicy and has big but supple tannic structure with long savory finish.

THE PLACE

Paso Robles is situated along U.S. Highway 101 in the center of California's Central Coast, halfway between San Francisco and Los Angeles. Warm, dry days throughout the summer make it ideal for growing big bold reds with no holds barred-like Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. The warm climate—similar to the Napa Valley—builds power and structure in the grapes. The 2019 vintage was relatively consistent and steady weather pattern that led to a ripe vintage producing bold wines filled with expressive fruit flavors and big but soft tannin structure.
