Vineyard

A unique dual appellation blend of our best hillside Sonoma and Napa vineyards. This one-of-a-kind composition marries the great Napa Cabernet vineyards of Altas Peak, Spring Mountain, Howell Mountain, Mt. Veeder, Calistoga, and Oakville with Sonoma's Chalk Hill, Sonoma Valley, Sonoma Coast, and our own B.R. Cohn Olive Hill Estate. The result is a complex, enticing, and rich Cabernet suited to your favorite cuisine.

Winemaking

All small vineyard lots are fermented and age separately, customizing the winemaking to each individual vineyard. Grapes are cold soaked for 3 to 4 days before fermentation in small open and closed top fermenters. All lots go through malolactic fermentation and 40 to 50% receive extracted maceration. The wines are aged for 22 months in only the best tight grain 3-year air-dried French Bordeaux barrels.

Tasting Notes

A rich bold style Cabernet built to go with food. Classic Cabernet aromas of cassis and plum yield to black cherry and briar. These harmonize with a bouquet of sweet French oak, cedar cigar box, clove, and a hint of anise and pine needle. The palate is medium-full bodied with rich plum and cherry flavors and round supple tannins on the long finish.
