In 1998, B.R. Cohn Winery introduced its Silver Label Cabernet Sauvignon, sourced from select vineyards throughout California's premium growing regions to broaden its national customer base. Building on the success of that wine, Vintage Wine Estates is pleased to introduce two new Silver Label wines in 2016: Silver Label Russian River Chardonnay and Silver Label North Coast Pinot Noir.

Vintage Details

From a truly great growing season, this Chardonnay is sourced from select vineyards in the acclaimed Russian River Valley region of Sonoma County, where the cool climate allows the grapes to develop ripe, rich flavors, while maintaining a bright and refreshing acidity.

Winemaking

This Chardonnay was cold settled and fermented clean using inoculated yeast strains at low temperatures to preserve the fresh aromas. The chardonnay saw regular battonage (lees stirring) during the first stage of its maturation. 100% Malolactic fermentation.

B.R. Cohn Winery

Just an hour's drive from San Francisco, B.R. Cohn Winery is a 90-acre multifaceted estate nestled between the Mayacamas Mountain Range and Sonoma Mountain in the heart of Sonoma Valley. With a winemaking history dating to the 1860s, the property encompasses the 61-acre Olive Hill Estate Vineyard, named for the 500 160-year-old Picholine olive trees on the property. The vineyard is planted primarily to Cabernet Sauvignon and benefits from a unique confluence of geological and climatic factors that keep its soils warm, its vines frost-free and its grapes ripe and flavor-packed. These advantages explain why B.R. Cohn is among Sonoma Valley's few producers of world-class, single-vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon.
