### Silver Label

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In 1998, B. R. Cohn Winery introduced its Silver Label tier, sourced from select vineyards throughout California's premium growing regions to broaden its national customer base.

### Winemaking

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Harvested at night and delivered cool to the winery. Destemmed and 100% whole berry, tank fermented for 14 days with regular cap management to control extraction. Pressed off and allowed to go through complete malolactic fermentation. Aged with French oak for 9 months.

### Vintage Details

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The B.R. Cohn Silver Label Pinot Noir is a medium-bodied, rich, smooth wine with notes of black cherry, raspberry and currant. It is sourced from vineyards throughout the cool northern coastal region of California, an ideal growing region for this grape.

### Vineyard Details

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Sourced from carefully selected vineyards around Lake County, Mendocino and Sonoma counties.

### Flavors & Aromas

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Silky mouthfeel, bursting with aromas of black cherry, raspberry, currant and spice. Soft tannins on the palate work well with the soft acidity to produce an extremely pleasurable wine.

### B.R. Cohn Winery

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Just an hour's drive from San Francisco, B.R. Cohn Winery is a 70-acre multifaceted estate nestled between the Mayacamas Mountain Range and Sonoma Mountain in the heart of Sonoma Valley. With a winemaking history dating to the 1860s, the property encompasses the 55-acre Olive Hill Estate Vineyard, named for the 500 160-year-old Picholine olive trees on the property. The vineyard is planted primarily to Cabernet Sauvignon and benefits from a unique confluence of geological and climatic factors that keep its soils warm, its vines frost-free and its grapes ripe and flavor-packed. These advantages explain why B.R. Cohn is among Sonoma Valley's few producers of world-class, single-vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon.
