2017 Cherry Pie Tri-County Pinot Noir

Fine quality Pinot Noir. It is full bodied, supple and ripely flavored; a wine with cherry, raspberry, rose petal, black tea, and toasty oak aromas/flavors, good balance, and a long finish. An excellent value.

Stanly Ranch

NAPA COUNTY

Located in the Napa side of the Carneros AVA, the acclaimed Stanly Ranch Vineyard is famed for its cool climate location due to its close proximity to the San Pablo portion of the San Francisco Bay.

Alta Loma Vineyard

MONTEREY COUNTY

Located in the Monterey County AVA, near the Santa Lucia AVA and overlooking the Salinas River Valley, Alta Loma is planted on Arroyo Seco gravelly loam soil. These sparse, well-drained soils reduce yields, creating rich, concentrated flavors in the fruit.

Los Alamos Vineyard

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

Tucked into a canyon in Santa Barbara County that leads directly to the Pacific Ocean, the sandy soils, bright sunshine and very cool ocean breezes combine to lengthen fruit ripening and extend hang time, resulting in intense aromatics and great acidity.
