## WELCOME TO THE HOME OF SINGLE AND MULTI-VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

Cherry Pie wines are all about one thing: location. Single and multi-vineyard wines that have a distinct sense of place from the finest vineyards in California. From cool, well-draining sites at sea-level to wind-blown, elevated vineyards on steep slopes, each cluster begins with the influence of its surroundings. Vineyards are chosen as if we are buying a home—carefully selecting a place to live, to set down roots, to embrace the culture of the neighborhood. A place that will leave a distinct imprint from harvest to bottle.

Our winemaking approach is gentle. Individual blocks are hand-picked with care for micro-lot fermentation to isolate distinct flavors and aromas. The majority of Cherry Pie wines are fermented in 500 liter French Oak Puncheons and punched down by hand. The wines are aged in French Oak, a portion of which return to the same puncheons they were fermented in; never racked or filtered, and rested 'sur lie' for the entire aging period, prior to bottling.

The care and hand-crafting doesn't stop with the wine. The nostalgic artwork of TR Colletta wraps each bottling in a warm, evocative embrace that welcomes you to our home—the vineyards of Cherry Pie.



# Cherry Pie

Visionary Winemaker Jayson Woodbridge always had a desire to make Pinot Noir. He contacted the owners of historic Stanly Ranch, in the Carneros appellation of Napa to craft his first Pinot Noir. He was shortly thereafter granted access to the very best blocks on the property to create his vision.

Inspired by his grandmother's baking and the artwork of TR Colletta, Cherry Pie is at once rich and layered, redolent of the flavors and aromas of something delicious and beautiful, being made with care.

Made in small, micro-fermented lots from the finest single-vineyards, you can expect Cherry Pie to uniquely represent the Pinot Noir varietal.



STANLY RANCH  
PINOT NOIR

**The vineyard:**

Historic vineyard (since 1880) at sea level, adjacent to San Pablo Bay. Gently rolling hills with clay-loam soils.

**Wine profile:**

Saturated ruby hue, concentrated black cherry and red fruit aromas introduce a full creamy palate. Layers, upon layers of fresh red fruit, strawberry jam, cocoa and toast. Mouthwatering, ripe red fruit and buttery vanilla linger on the palate. Beautifully textured and ready to enjoy.



RODGERS CREEK  
PINOT NOIR

**The vineyard:**

500-600 Above Sea Level with consistent wind through the Petaluma Gap. Named for the fault line it straddles.

**Wine profile:**

Ruby to garnet in the glass – the nose offers gorgeous, juicy layers of blueberries, raspberries and bramble with smoky bacon and delicate hints of mineral and pastoral earth. The palate is luscious and filling. Big, round and satisfying – this Pinot Noir finishes with even more blueberries, smoked meat and toasty vanilla.



HUCKLEBERRY SNODGRASS  
PINOT NOIR

**The vineyard:**

Less than 10 miles from the Pacific Ocean – cool, growing season. Goldridge loam soil and sand create excellent drainability.

**Wine profile:**

Showcasing a racier side of Russian River Valley Pinot Noir, the aromas are of raspberry jam, wild strawberries, fig and rhubarb. Notes of smoky vanilla and cola are balanced by spicy fruit compote and ripe, structured tannins on the palate. The finish is lingers with Bing cherry and dark chocolate.

Inspired by the Rodgers Creek Vineyard during harvest for Cherry Pie single vineyard Pinot Noir, winemaker Jayson Woodbridge was struck with a new concept: applying his “micro fermentation” technique to create single-vineyard blend from three vineyards, in three distinct regions.

Utilizing an artisan winemaking approach of selecting fruit from specific vineyard blocks, micro-fermenting small, individual lots in open-top puncheon barrels and aging in French oak, Cherry Tart combines the best of three distinct vineyards in three distinct AVAs that showcase layer upon layer of complexity.



## PINOT NOIR

Wine profile:

Aromas of raspberry, nutmeg, sandalwood and light smokiness, lifted by a floral note jump from the glass. Silky and delicate up front, with ripe acidity framing the rich, sweet flavors of red berries, red cherry and earth. Offers good fat without excess weight, finishing with a fine dusting of tannins and very good length.

## CHARDONNAY

Wine profile:

Abundant floral and aromas of lychee nut, honeysuckle, and peach marmalade jump from the glass. Incredibly rich and textured, with loads of caramelized pear, pineapple and exotic marmalade notes, our Chardonnay has brilliant delineation and stunning length with undeniable minerality.




