"The 2018 Chardonnay sings of lime blossoms, pink grapefruit and green mango with hints of lemon zest and coriander seed. Medium to full-bodied, it has a lovely satiny texture and great intensity, finishing on a lingering lemon/lime note."

"Nose of apricot and orange marmalade, whipped honey, graham cracker, yellow flowers. Lush texture, full and smooth, but moderate acidity keeps it lively. Lovely depth, very delicious."
