COMPOSITION

82% Petite Sirah, 10% Zinfandel, 7% Malbec and 1% Grenache

TASTING NOTES

This Petite Sirah is inky in the glass, revealing heady aromas of blackberry, toffee and chocolate. On the palate the ripe black fruit flavors are enveloped with creamy mocha, toasted oak spice and hints of vanilla. The firm finish is marked by refined tannins and a refreshing lift of lively acidity.

WINEMAKING NOTES

2016 was another near perfect growing season with idyllic weather throughout the year. Harvest was a bit earlier than usual, and yields were balanced. Most importantly, the quality of fruit was once again impressive, marked by complex aromatics and flavors for this highly-coveted wine.
