COMPOSITION

79% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Petit Verdot, 3.5% Merlot, 2.5% Syrah

TASTING NOTES

The nose of our 2014 Napa Cabernet is rich with warming aromas of vanilla and baking spice. The palate is brooding with flavors of cocoa powder dusted boysenberries. Bright acidity and French oak co-mingle nicely and the wine finishes with velvety, well-integrated tannins.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Early rains in the spring help budding vines thrive and 2014 gave us an above average yield. In the third year of a drought in California the berry sizes remained slightly small which in turn gave us concentrated flavors and structure. The 2014 harvest showcased a well-developed balance of acidity and fruit character. Overall, the 2014 harvest will be considered yet another high-quality vintage for Napa Valley.
