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## 2014 RESERVE FIELD BLEND, RED WINE BLEND, NAPA VALLEY

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### COMPOSITION

A field blend believed to include Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre and Zinfandel

### TASTING NOTES

The nose is rich in both floral and baking spices, while powerful fruit-forward flavors of ripe cherry, plum and blackberry dominate the palate while delicate hints of vanilla and baking spice linger on the finish. This elegantly balanced wine will continue to age for up to ten years in your cellar.

### WINEMAKING NOTES

Early rains in the spring helped budding vines thrive and 2014 gave us an above average yield. In the third year of a drought in California, the berry sizes remained slightly small which in turn gave us concentrated flavors and structure. The 2014 harvest showcased a well-developed balance of acidity and fruit character thanks to the even ripening.

### ABOUT THIS WINE

This wine is an homage to California's winegrowing heritage. When immigrants first settled in California, they brought with them traditional winegrowing techniques and vine cuttings from their Old-World villages. The cuttings were planted and grew into a vineyard with multiple grape varieties, rather than a single variety (as is a more common method of planting vineyards today). These "field blends" produced wines to be shared among family and traded with neighbors. Our "Field Blend" is a nod to the farmers who settled in wine country.
