COMPOSITION

86% Sangiovese, 14% Zinfandel

TASTING NOTES

On the nose this Sangiovese reveals aromas of Bing cherry, strawberry jam, violet, leather and dried fruits. The palate is laden with dark plum, black fruit, leather, cola and rhubarb. Hints of pepper spice and freshly baked pie crust meld into a lifted mid-palate supported by supple tannins, and hints of baking spice on the finish.

WINEMAKING NOTES

The 2015 vintage was marked by another year of drought in the Napa Valley. While quality was high, yields were low. Fortunately, that which we did harvest was endowed with depth of character, and concentrated flavors. We were able to pick at phenolic ripeness while maintaining moderate sugar levels, affording us the chance to craft wines with moderate alcohol, lively acidity and bright fruit flavors.
