



2018 SAUVIGNON BLANC SONOMA COUNTY

VINEYARD NOTES

Sourced from a variety of vineyards throughout the Sonoma Coast appellation, each chosen for their high-quality fruit, and the unique character they lend to this Sauvignon Blanc.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2018 vintage proved nearly ideal with even ripening and a long, evenly paced harvest. Yields were slightly below average and grape quality was quite high. The select vineyard sources for this lively white wine afford an abundance of character and when blended together they form a seamlessly refreshing sipper.

WINEMAKER NOTES

This Sauvignon Blanc highlights a classic profile of jasmine, citrus and tropical fruits nose. The lively palate reveals zingy notes of lemon zest, flavors of Granny Smith apples, and white peaches finishing with a firm and refreshing twist—a true palate quenching Sauvignon Blanc.
