



2017 Reserve Sangiovese

Case Production-	84 cases produced
Blend -	100% Sangiovese
Vineyard Sources -	100% Ciel du Cheval Vineyard Red Mountain
Alcohol -	14.4%
Cooperage -	20% new oak, combination of French, American and Hungarian oak.
Winemaking -	Crushed gently and dropped by gravity into 1.5 ton bins, cold soaked 48 hours, then inoculated with a variety of yeasts, hand punched and pressed directly to barrel where the wine finished both primary and secondary fermentations.
Tasting Note -	The 2017 Tamarack Sangiovese leads with bold fruit on the nose, including red currant, raspberry and blood orange, with notes of fresh ground nutmeg. On the palate, purple plum and cloves lead to a rich, savory mid-palate followed by a smooth finish.
Appellation -	Red Mountain
