VINTAGE & VINEYARD

In 2012, the growing season began early, and the lack of rain resulted in small, concentrated berries bursting with intense flavors. Our Sonoma County Vineyards were blessed with consistent temperatures and cool nights, yielding fruit with great acid and tannin structure. Cabernets from this vintage in the Sonoma Valley will age well, but ours is also delicious when opened now.

TASTING NOTES

Deep black fruit characterizes our Cabernet Sauvignon, with distinctive accents of cedar and mocha from 18 months of aging in French oak barrels. Enjoy now or cellar for the next eight to ten years.

PERFECT PAIRINGS

The bold tannins and dark red fruit of this wine makes it a good companion to hearty dishes with beef, bison or lamb. Another delicious pairing is sun dried tomato pesto or grilled eggplant with olive oil and Italian herbs.
