VINTAGE & VINEYARD

The 2012 growing season was long and steady, for slow, complete ripening. This wine was sourced from our hillside estate, where grapes developed deep fruit character in warm afternoon sunlight. Cool, misty mornings maintained good balance between fruit and acidity—a key component to easy food pairing.

TASTING NOTES

Primitivo is a grape that is known for its propensity to ripen before all other varietals, which means that it develops pigmentation and rich flavors easily. Boysenberry aromas and flavors are the star, but the supporting cast is black pepper and sweet mocha with cameos promoted by the two years in oak—nutty vanilla and spice.

PERFECT PAIRINGS

This hearty, robust reserve Primitivo pairs incredibly well with roast lamb, wood-fired pizza or eggplant parmesan.
