VINTAGE & VINEYARD

The 2013 growing season in the Sonoma Valley featured steady temperatures from the onset, helping our fruit on the vine to ripen evenly resulting in a large, full-flavored vintage.

TASTING NOTES

The 2013 Viansa Chardonnay Sonoma Valley reveals aromas of crisp apple and sweet citrus peel, followed by notes of Meyer Lemon curd on the palate. Complex hints of Tahitian vanilla and baking spice, imparted during six months of aging in oak barrels, balance the bright fruit character.

PERFECT PAIRINGS

This is a crisp wine with an appealing acidity that brings out the depth of flavor in seafood dishes like crab cakes and grilled salmon. It tastes great with quick, casual weeknight meals, too, like chicken Caesar salad or take-out Pad Thai—and be sure to keep a chilled bottle on hand for after work aperitifs or an impromptu cheese plate.
