VINTAGE & VINEYARD

The 2013 growing season in Sonoma County featured the kind of warm, steady daytime temperatures, and cool crisp evenings, that develop intense varietal character in Pinot Noir grapes. The balanced tannins and acidity of this wine allows it to stand up to a variety of different foods.

TASTING NOTES

Ripe cherry, coco and coffee aromas are accented by a sweet spiciness. On the palate, this wine exhibits dark fruit flavors of plum with suggestions of spicy clove, licorice and mushrooms. The round mouthfeel is perfectly complemented by a finish of caramel and vanilla cola.

PERFECT PAIRINGS

Try serving this supple, earthy wine with turkey and pork, or recipes that feature mushrooms like chanterelles or truffles.
