VINTAGE & VINEYARD

The 2013 growing season in Sonoma featured warm, steady, daytime temperatures that developed intense varietal character, tannins and acidity. This wine is made up of classic varietals grown in Sonoma County. Each year, our Winemaker Amy puts a blend together using different percentages based on the quality from the vintage.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2013 Vino Rosso opens with notes of raspberry, cranberry, vanilla, cinnamon and mocha. The wine exhibits a wonderful balance of bright acidity and lingering red fruit and spice notes. This wine finishes beautifully with raspberry pie notes, dried herbs and tobacco.

PERFECT PAIRINGS

This supple wine would compliment a Rotisserie chicken served alongside roasted root vegetables, or a seared salmon with raspberry glaze.
