Smooth on the palate, and the lighter in style, the Paso Robles Syrah opens up with ripe red cherry and jammy berries framed by subtle floral notes and black pepper. Lingering, toasty-oak finish. This Syrah spent 5 months in French Oak Chips.

A glass of our Syrah will be a big hit, served up with braised short rib sliders on game night. At your next fondue party you'll find that the smooth tannins and bright acidity make our Syrah a delicious match.

Centrally located halfway between San Francisco and Los Angeles along California's Central Coast, Paso Robles is home to distinct soils, many micro-climates, and extraordinary topography. This region is famous for Zinfandel and Rhone varietals, as well as distinct blends unique to the area. Vines in this region have plenty of time to produce fully mature fruit, while overnight cooling keeps the grapes' acidity in balance. Wines sourced from this AVA are generally full-bodied wines with rich fruit character, softer tannins and lower acidity.
