

This Zinfandel has rich and balanced aromas of cedar, caramel and dark red fruit. There is a succulent mouthfeel with hints of cranberry, boysenberry and, black currant. The finish is vanilla, graham cracker and chocolate that lingers.

Windsor Recommends

Sonoma County has a long and storied history of producing some of the best Zinfandel in the world. This wine is a classic example. Pair with tomato-based dishes, grilled foods, slow-cooked dishes and roasted meats such as beef tenderloin with roasted potatoes or chicken parmesan.

This wine is sourced from our vineyards just west of Santa Rosa in the Russian River Valley. The grapes are grown on ancient volcanic soil, level to the valley floor, perfect terroir for Zinfandel.
